F. General Instructions, terms & conditions

- (1) The candidate must be a citizen of India
- (2) There is no age limit for the posts of Professor & Associate Professor. However, for the posts of Assistant Professor, upper age limit for fresh candidates shall be 40 years as on the last date of application, with relaxation of 05 years in case of OBC and SC/ST category and 10 years in case of physically handicapped candidates.
- (3) The retirement age for all teaching posts will be as per University Rules.
- (4) Reservation Rules issued by State Government of U.P. will be applicable. The claimant for reservation must furnish the certificate as applicable, issued by the competent authority.
- (5) The posts will be filled on regular basis. These posts are temporary but likely to continue.
- (6) The main responsibility of the recruited faculty will be teaching of UG and PG Courses, development of course curriculum and establishment of laboratories.
