Student strength

The College is imparting B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree course as per the norms of Veterinary Council of India. Presently, 152 students of B.V.Sc. & A.H., 43 Students of M.V.Sc. and 2 students of Ph.D. are studying in the college.

Maintenance of Livestock and birds

The College is maintaining the different animals like Cattle, Buffal, Pig, Sheep, Goat, Horse and birds for teaching purpose. There is fish pond and a model integrated farming system. The college is self sufficient for production of green fodder utilized by the farm animals. In the current year the egg and milk production is 9414 (numbers) and 59,574 liter, respectively. The product of the above livestock and birds are being sold to the employees at the fixed price approved by university. Rs. 27,22,033 (Twenty seven Lakh twenty two thousand thirty three rupees only) has been generated through sale of Milk Coupons, Paneer, Poultry, Eggs, Chicks, Pointed gourd

(Parwal), Mushroom, Farm Yard Manure, Auction of Animals And Levy from registration of animals for treatment and Artificial Insemination.
