199:1201 To consider and approve the proposed change in credit of 0+1 to 1+0 in course No. PGS 501 and renumber it as LIB 511 as proposed by the Dean, Home Science.

The Council approved the proposed change.

199:1202 To consider and approve to start part-time Ph.D. programme in selected departments of College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry.

After a long discussion the Council resolved to allow registration in Ph.D. programme of such teachers who have completed five years of regular service in this University and cannot be conveniently allowed study leave for joining Ph.D. programme in an outside University as their services are required in teaching of the courses. Admission to such Ph.D. programme would be done after conducting an interview by a committee constituted for the purpose. Such teachers would not be allowed any relaxation in their teaching course load on account of joining Ph.D. studies. Such teachers will be required to undertake prescribed course and research credits. The candidates will be required to sign a bond to serve the University for a period of six years after completion of Ph.D. degree.

This facility will be operative from the 2nd Semester 2009-10 in all the faculties of the University. Necessary proposals are to be moved well in advance through proper channel to avoid last minute rush at the start of semester.

To consider and approve for execution of UGC Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree Regulation, 2009 as per UGC notification dated June 1st, 2009 (copy enclosed).

The Council discussed the regulation point-wise and resolved to adopt with minor modification as most of the provisions are already being followed in this University like admission through Joint Entrance Examination, course-cum-research work, pre-thesis submission seminar and incorporation of suggestions. It was decided to assess the progress in terms of publication of two research papers which are submitted before thesis submission. It was also decided that the existing system of submission of two research papers will continue for the time being. One of the Ph.D. thesis examiners will henceforth be invariably from out of State, the panels of examiners would be sent accordingly in two parts; Part-A from the State, Part-B from out of the State keeping five experts in each group.
