The College of Home Science now rechristened as Community Science. The under graduate teaching at the Agricultural University is now recognized by the Uttar Pradesh Services Commission for Agricultural Services (category-3) assistant group C (General selection) increasing the scope of the graduates and considered them equivalent to agriculture graduate. The subject as a discipline is growing in function and more responsibility towards Community development especially with respect to State Agricultural Universities where Home Science is now being called as Community Science. The degree programmes focus not only just the family or home but also to a larger social unit i.e., community. The

curriculum recommended by the 5th Deans Committee is aimed at preparing the students not just for collar jobs but to be their own boss through entrepreneurship.

Teaching

The College of Home Science at N. D. University of Agriculture and Technology during 2017-2018 taught two parallel curriculums - one recommended by 4th Deans Committee to the students of 3rd and 4th year and the curriculum taught to 1st and 2nd year students was as per the recommendation of 5th Deans Committee Report. Five departments are involved in providing education on the following subjects:

The final year's students took Internship/Industrial attachment in different Institutes – namely U.P. Institute of Entrepreneurial Development, Government Food Preservation Center, Jingle Bells School, and NGO, while the students in their 1st year were taught basic and fundamental courses and the II year students understood the principles of the subject. The undergraduate students are also offered and taught Basic core and common courses that include subjects like English language, Statistics, Biochemistry, Environmental Studies and Disaster Management, Human Physiology, Food Microbiology, Personality Development, Economics and Rural Sociology.

Research

Post graduate education:

The College provided education for the M.Sc. (Home Science). There were two students in Food Science and Nutrition and one in Home Science extension and Communication Management who submitted her thesis and the viva was conducted on 9.7.2018. The students during their degree programme are educated with respect to advances in their field and provided basic training to conduct research through the research work.

Infrastructure and Equipments at the College

The College has all the basic infrastructure and equipments for U.G. & P.G. teaching. The Laboratory nursery school of the Department of Human Development and Family Studies has a unique feature usually not available in other Colleges is the One way observation window to enable indirect observation of children and the activities being performed in the Laboratory. The students get involved in the doing the practical work themselves on the principle of learning by doing. The Canteen run by students is regularly organized on different themes, while Family Resource Management uses its lab to encourage students to try out different interiors and set ups towards entrepreneurial venture.
